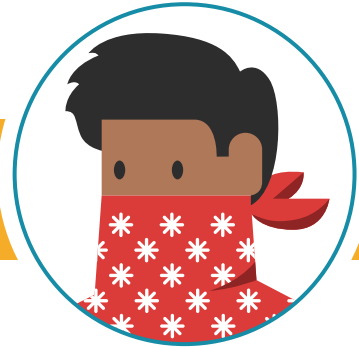


For Everyone's Health and Safety

A Face Covering or Mask **MUST** Be Worn Here—At All Times.



- ✓ **Face coverings help prevent illnesses like COVID-19 from spreading to others while speaking, coughing, or sneezing.**
- ✓ **Your face covering can be a scarf, bandana, or a homemade mask.**
- ✓ **It should cover your mouth AND your nose.**

In addition to wearing a face covering, be sure to maintain 6 feet of physical distance between yourself and others and wash hands often with soap for 20 seconds.

FACE COVERINGS OR MASKS SHOULD NOT BE WORN IF:

- ✗ **You have trouble breathing or are unable to remove the mask without help**
- ✗ **Your health conditions prohibit wearing a face covering**

As of May 29, 2020: Any person age 10 or older must wear a face covering at all times while entering, exiting, traveling through, and spending time in indoor public settings as mandated by the Governor of Virginia's Executive Order 63.
